We are the delivery body for the Government Hubs Programme, which is supporting economic growth across the UK. It's a catalyst for regenerating brownfield sites, returning shoppers to high streets and turning unused buildings into collaborative, modern workspaces.

The Programme is rationalising the Government's office estate in cities and towns across the UK. We have supported 15,000 roles to be relocated out of London under Places for Growth.

Through the Programme, we are delivering modern, customer-focused, digitally connected and inclusive workplaces to enable government departments to share space and work productively.







Smarter working empowers us with choices about where, when and how we work. Underpinned by culture, ethos, process and technology, smarter working is about optimising working environments to simplify processes, generate greater productivity, and realise cost savings through efficiencies.

We have been leading the Civil Service transformation to smarter working since 2018 by supporting government departments to implement smarter working practices. We have supported 30 departments to achieve Smarter Working Maturity. This means these departments have provided demonstrable evidence of how their people, culture, leadership, technology and workspaces are benchmarking smarter ways of working.

CREATING AN INTEROPERABLE PORTFOLIO WHITEHALL

The Whitehall Campus Programme is transforming the UK Government's central London office portfolio to create a smaller, better, greener office estate.

We are investing in Whitehall office buildings to create a campus of interoperable buildings that nurture flexibility, productivity and wellbeing, while maintaining the historic architecture that lies at the heart of government.

All buildings within the Campus will be refurbished or retrofitted to meet the Government Workplace Design Guide, to craft inclusive and productive work spaces while improving sustainability and cost efficiencies. Our Property Technology solutions will enable real-time monitoring for occupancy and building performance.





We are leading the Government's drive towards emissions reduction across its office portfolio. In late 2020, we established a Net Zero Programme to reduce energy consumption, increase the use of green energy, generate and store green energy locally, and reduce embodied carbon across the Government's office portfolio.

And we are also going beyond just reducing carbon emissions. We are building resilience to climate change by mitigating against future flood risks, temperature rises and other environmental changes.

We already work with sustainable technologies and low and zero carbon energy wherever possible. And when it comes to making our buildings sustainable, we are leading by example by committing to a 78% reduction in carbon emissions across the Government's office portfolio three years sooner than the Government's target.



Our Net Zero and sustainability initiatives are implemented as early as possible, beginning at construction design stage whenever possible right from the very beginning of our journey with you. That means we start at the construction design stage, whenever possible.

Our new Croydon Hub build, for example, has been designed to exceed the criteria for Building Research Establishment Environmental Assessment Method (BREEAM) 'Excellent' standard, and is partially heated through energy generated by the building's façades.



ENHANCING SKILLS

We are innovators, driven to continuously question, learn and improve. We currently employ more than 450 people who are passionate about their role in transforming the Civil Service and creating great places to work.

Our diverse training and development routes ensure we remain at the forefront of the property industry, as well as across professional specialisms. Whether we're introducing the next generation of leaders through the Fast Stream programme, empowering our people to achieve Gold Standard accreditations, or identifying and nurturing talent through talent recognition programmes such as Inspire and Impact, it results in a skilled and engaged workforce that offers unrivalled value to our departmental partners and their people.

We've expanded our team to include both private and public sector expertise, with specialists from across property, capital projects, renovation and retrofitting, sustainability and energy management, IT, data and technology, finance, HR, security, workplace design, workplace experience and health and safety.



FACILITATING URBAN REGENERATION PETERBOROUGH

Quay House in Peterborough is our first new-build Government Hub within the Government Hubs Programme. It sits at the gateway of Fletton Quays, and is a crucial part of the £120 million regeneration project for Peterborough. The Hub was opened in March 2023 to 1,200 civil servants from five government bodies, including Defra, Joint Nature Conservation Committee, Environment Agency, Natural England and the HM Passport Office.

Quay House is expected to save an estimated £9.1 million (based on a 20-year NPV) in operating costs and estate rationalisation, returning money to the public purse.
